

Class Dialog for Class #10 (Numbers and simple math)

Using only the vocabulary we have learned so far, learn how to say everything below in Italian (except what is in " "), print out and bring the printable form of this dialog and be prepared to say the dialog below for one of the persons in class.

Person #1 – Hi _____,

Person #2 – Hi ______, how are you?

Person #1 – I am well, And you? How are you?

Person #2 - I am very well. What are you doing?

Person #1 – How do you say "to count" in Italian?

Person #2 – You say "contare".

Person #1 – I am counting my glasses.

Person #2 – "Quanti" glasses do you have?

Person #1 - What does "Quanti" mean?

Person #2 – "Quanti" means "how many or how much?"

Person #1 – I don't know. There are twelve glasses on the table.

Person #2 – There are twenty seven glasses on the floor.

Person #1 – Twelve plus twenty seven equals thirty nine.

Person #2- How may glasses do you need?

Person #1 – I need forty glasses.

Person #2– Why do you need forty glasses?

Person #1 – Because there are twenty friends at my house and they need a glass for water and a glass for wine. Twenty times two equals forty.

Person #2 – You are right but forty minus thirty nine equals one, you need one glass.

Person #1 – Now you are right. I need to go shopping to buy a glass.

Person #2— You don't need to go shopping to buy a glass. I have a glass in my car.

Person #1 – Fantastic! Thank you very much!
