



## Class dialog for verb drills 12

### (Adding more irregular past participles)

Try to learn how to say everything below in Italian (using the simple present tense for the progressive present), print out and bring the printable form of this dialog and be prepared to say the dialog below for one of the persons in class.

Person #1 - Are you ready (pronto)?

Person #2 - No, I'm not ready. I was ready but not now.

Person #1 - Why? What happened?

Person #2 - Remember my brother (mio fratello), Bruno?

Person #1 - Yes, he and my sister (mia sorella) were born the same day.

Person #2 - I started to get ready to go out with you after they left.

Person #1 - When did they leave?

Person #2 - They left eight hours ago!

Person #2 - When I thought that I was almost ready, I took my shoes (le mie scarpe) and I found a surprise (una sorpresa)!

Person #2 - There was food in my shoes. In fact, it was soup (zuppa)! Then, I went into the kitchen to wash my shoes and I noticed a smell (odore).

Person #1 - Another surprise?

Person #2 - Yeah. They put my keys (le mie chiavi) in the oven (forno) and then they turned it on.

Person #1 - You can't drive now? What will we do now? Ugh, I'm sorry but I gotta go, good luck! Oh, I almost forgot to tell you.

Person #2 - Yes, tell me!

Person #1 - Your cat (gatto) is in your mailbox (casella di posta). Bye!
