



## Class dialog for verb drills 6 (Adding irregular IRE verbs)

Try to learn how to say everything below in Italian (using the simple present tense for the progressive present), print out and bring the printable form of this dialog and be prepared to say the dialog below for one of the persons in class.

Person #1 – Hi \_\_\_\_\_.

Person #2 – Hi \_\_\_\_\_, how are you?

Person #1 – I am very well, thank you. And you, How are you?

Person #2 – I am well, thank you. Paul says that you work in (a) Rome, is that true?

Person #1 – Yes, it's true. I work with the police (polizia).

Person #2 – It must be very interesting to work in Rome with the police!

Person #1 – Certainly, it is interesting but it is also (anche) sad (triste). People often (spesso) die. Do you see Paul often?

Person #2 – We go out every (ogni) week. Sometimes (qualche volta) I go to Paul's and sometimes he comes to my house.

Person #1 – What do y'all do when y'all go out?

Person #2 – We climb a lot. We say that we walk a lot but it is not true (non è vero).

Person #1 – Y'all say that you walk a lot but it is not true? I say y'all lie! Do y'all climb or do you lie when you say y'all climb? I know that Paul Climbs. I climb with him!

Person #2 – Come to my house and ask Paul if we climb.

Person #1 – I am not coming today (oggi). Today I go out with my wife.

Person #2 – Ok, my parents (i miei genitori) come to my house today. Do you remember my parents?

Person #1 – I do remember your (i tuoi) parents, I like them a lot! Do they come often?

Person #2 – My dad always comes to my house, my mom doesn't.

Person #1 – I am sorry but I have to leave now. I teach an Italian at 8:00 (alle otto).

Person #2 – Ok, good luck. See you soon!

Person #1 – Thank you, goodbye
