

## Conjugating regular Italian verbs ending with IRE in the present tense

Here are the conjugated endings for IRE verbs;

Subject Pronoun	Ending
Io	o
Tu	i
Lui/Lei	e
Noi	iamo
Voi	ite
Loro	ono

To conjugate = infinitive verb – infinitive ending = verb stem + conjugated ending = conjugated verb.  
**Servire (To Serve) - ire = Serv + iamo (ending for we) = Serviamo (We see)**

Servire conjugated in the present tense

Io	Servo	I serve
Tu	Servi	You serve
Lui/Lei	Serve	He/She/It serves
Noi	Serviamo	We serve
Voi	Servite	Y'all serve
Loro	Servono	They serve

(Conjugation pattern for ISC Verbs)

**Capire (To Understand) - ire = Cap + isc = capisc + ono (ending for they) = Capiscono (They understand)**

Capire conjugated in the present tense

Io	Capisco	I understand
Tu	Capisci	You understand
Lui/Lei	Capisce	He/She/It understands
Noi	Capiamo	We understand
Voi	Capite	Y'all understand
Loro	Capiscono	They understand
