Italian Verb Conjugation – Regular ARE verbs

To conjugate = infinitive verb – infinitive ending = verb stem + conjugated ending = conjugated verb. Example;
Parlare (To Speak) - are = Parl + iamo (ending for we) = Parliamo (We speak)

Subject Pronoun	Conjugated Ending	Infinitive Stem	Conjugated Verb	English Translation
Io	o	Parl	Parlo	I speak
Tu	i	Parl	Parli	You speak
Lui/Lei	a	Parl	Parla	He/She speaks
Noi	iamo	Parl	Parliamo	We speak
Voi	ate	Parl	Parlate	Y'all speak
Loro	ano	Parl	Parlano	They speak

A few other regular ARE verbs to practice conjugating;

Cantare	to sing	Ballare	to dance	Domandare	to ask
Abitare	to live	Arrivare	to arrive	Cenare	to eat dinner
Lavorare	to work	Volare	to fly	Ascoltare	to listen

Appena	just	Dopo	after
Gia	already	Di solito	usually
Spesso	often	Mai	ever
Presto	soon	Raramente	rarely
Sempre	always	Lentamente	slowly
Rapidamente	quickly	Ancora	still
Non ... mai	never	Non ... più	not any more
Non ... ancora	not yet		

The present tense of the irregular Italian ARE verb Andare (to go)

Andare

Io	vado
Tu	vai
Lui/Lei	va
Noi	andiamo
Voi	andate
Loro	vanno
